As part of efforts aimed at improving public understanding of extractive sector issues and the applicability of the Nigeria Natural Resource Charter (NNRC)'s Precepts/Principles in engaging with stakeholders and government agencies and NASS to resolve governance issues, the NNRC partnered with Extractives 360 in launching of its dedicated News website in Abuja in March.
